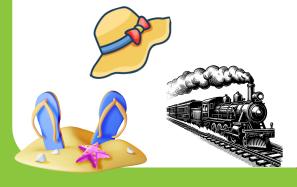

Colouring and Crafts



Facilitator Guide

Creative activities like colouring and simple crafts offer more than just fun. They provide opportunities for gentle focus, sensory stimulation, and expression — all without the pressure of "getting it right." These activities are inclusive, calming, and easy to adapt to different abilities and energy levels.

Standard Colouring Pages

How to Use:

Offer a small selection at a time (2–3 choices works well)
Use a mix of felt-tips and coloured pencils (thicker pens for those with reduced grip)

Play quiet music or use the time to chat one-to-one Encourage freedom — no "right" colours!

Tips:

Try pairing a colouring page with a themed conversation prompt (e.g. Colouring a beach hut → "Did you ever visit a beach like this?")

Display finished pictures in communal areas or personal rooms

For those with limited dexterity, try partially coloured sheets to complete

Interactive Craft: Under the Sea Scene

This activity includes a background scene and a sheet of fish and sea creatures to cut out, colour, and stick on — creating a personal ocean display. How to Use:

- 1. Provide each person with one sea background and a copy of the fish sheets
- 2. Invite them to colour the fish and sea creatures in their own style
- 3. Support with cutting if needed, or pre-cut shapes for those with motor difficulties
- 4. Use glue sticks or blu tack to place the fish on the background

Tips:

- Encourage imagination fish can be purple and striped, or glittery and spotty
- Make it collaborative: join several sea scenes together to create a group ocean mural
- Use it as a conversation point: "Have you ever been to an aquarium or paddled in a rockpool?"
